

Excerpt from the minutes of the Southeast Planning Review and Adjustment Committee, January 23, 2019, Moncton Lions Community Centre, 473 St. George Street

It was moved by Committee Member Edgar LeBlanc and seconded by Committee Member Hilyard Rossiter that the Southeast Planning Review and Adjustment Committee APPROVE the application by Bowers Construction (agent) on PID 70075304, British Settlement, to establish a quarry subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) That an Approval to Operate be issued by DELG [Dept of the Environment and Local Government] for the proposed quarry;**
- 2) That an Access Permit shall be obtained from the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure; and**
- 3) That prior to the issuance of a development permit, a legal document identifying the use of a right-of-way as access to a quarry operation be submitted;**
- 4) The main entrance to the quarry shall have a barrier to control access to the site**
- 5) For public safety, signs shall be placed at each entrance (main entrance, secondary entrance, tracks and/or trails, etc.) bearing the word "Danger", the nature of the operation and a no trespassing; and**
- 6) That the following terracing and sloping standards shall apply**
 - a) where the excavation is less than 6.0m in depth, it shall have a slope of not more than 30**
 - b) where the excavation is over 6.0m in depth, it shall have a terrace of not less than 6.0 m in width and at each 6.0m interval of the**
