Subject: Request for Information under the *Right to Information and Protection of Privacy Act*

I am writing about your request under the *Right to Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, dated March 7, 2023. We have reviewed and processed your request and are granting access to information relating to the damage and repairs to the Highway 2 bridge overpass near Trans Canada Highway Exit 504 in Sackville. Time Period: February 3, 2023 to March 7, 2023.

With respect to the documentation obtained in our Department, some documents or parts thereof were excluded, severed or not available based on the following exemptions under the Act:

21(1) The head of a public body shall refuse to disclose personal information to an applicant if the disclosure would be an unreasonable invasion of a third party's privacy.

For example: Names and cellular numbers.

26(1) The head of a public body may refuse to disclose information to an applicant if disclosure could reasonably be expected to reveal

(a) advice, opinions, proposals or recommendations developed by or for the public body or a Minister of the Crown

For example: Project considerations and/or recommendations.

In addition, if information was deemed to be duplicate in nature or out of scope as per the intent of the Right to Information request, it was identified as irrelevant and severed.

If you are not satisfied with this decision, you may file a complaint with the Office of the Ombud – Access and Privacy Division as per section 67(1)(a)(i) within 40 business days of receiving this response or refer the matter to a judge of the Court of King’s Bench as per section 65(1)(a) within 40 business days of receiving this response.
